


## New housing developments are on their way to Noblesville

## Same-sex marriages halted after emergency stay

After 48 hours and hundreds of licenses granted, same-sex marriages have been halted in Indiana.

The United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit granted an emergency motion for a stay of the Wednesday ruling by District Court Judge Richard Young that threw out Indiana's ban on same-sex marriage. The stay was granted around 6 p.m. Friday evening.

Indiana Attorney General Greg Zoeller filed the motion late Friday afternoon after no decision had been made on his earlier appeal to the District Court. Zoeller had filed that appeal on Wednesday afternoon, immediately after Young's ruling.

Zoeller plans to appeal Young's ruling.

On Friday, Hamilton County issued 16 same-sex marriage licenses out of 30 overall. This followed 41 couples receiving licenses the previous two days.

Marion County issued 586 licenses during the two-day period.



# **McCauley sees NHS win 2**

Every high school basketball coach will tell you the same thing about summer basketball. They play in the summer to get better, to improve.

No different for new Noblesville coach Brian McCauley. Except for one thing. McCauley is trying to learn more about his new players, and the players the same about their coach.

"The scoreboard isn't important," McCauley said after watching his Millers play three games Friday in the opening session of the Super Hoops summer tourney at Marion. "The scoreboard is fun for the kids, but our goal is to get better."

McCauley, likely, isn't going to disregard the scoreboard completely. Noblesville won two pool play games and lost a third by three points.

The Millers opened the day by putting the hammer to a young (only one returning player from last season) Portage team. The Millers blasted to a 22-5 first half (15 minutes, running clock) advantage.

Then, Noblesville lost to Valparaiso, 30-27, before ending the day with another convincing victory, beating Warsaw, 36-31.

McCauley said what he liked most during the day was, "How hard the kids played. I liked the way they played together. We had three good games at the Fishers Fieldhouse last weekend. We're starting to come together as a team."

Typical of summer basketball, Noblesville didn't have a full team at Marion. Neither did Hamilton Heights, which is playing in the same pool as Noblesville.

Heights coach Chad Ballenger also is looking for summer improvement from his Huskies, but, unlike McCauley, Ballenger is no stranger to his team. He is returning most of the Huskies who played last season.

Hamilton Heights went to Marion yesterday missing three potential starters, two big men (Kurry Miller and Garrett Paul) and a shooting guard (Jadon White).

Noblesville is playing without Jake Mills, Austin Ginther and David Cory, who was expected to play point guard last year but was sidelined for the season with an injury. Mills, a double-digit scorer last season, is injured, and that is giving Noblesville lots of concern.


