



"That is a good example of some of the developments that

have recently been proposed for Noblesville. It is located just south of us in Fishers at 37 & 131 Street," Zeckel points to. "In this new development they have the multi-housing component along with a new smaller Wal-Mart and several new retail businesses, including many new restaurants that are coming into the area."

Zeckel, as did other Council members, asked Planning Director Christy Langley how Noblesville compares percentage-wise to other communities in multi-family housing. Langley said a study is underway.

"I think it is important to find out the national or regional average for the percentage of multi-housing units in a community of comparable size," Zeckel said. "We can then see how Noblesville stacks up. The last information we received Planning the Department, Noblesville's percentage of multi-housing is around 10 percent of our total housing stock. Are we below the average at 10 percent, or are we above?

"If it is determined Noblesville is below the average percentage," Zeckel continued, "I am more inclined to approve additional apartments, given that the applicant has met all other requirements. If Noblesville is

Schools above the average, I would be more inclined not to approve additional apartments. Most of the new However, we also need to look at the type of multi-units proposed. For example, if it is determined out of our total number of apartments, we lack retirement units, I would be inclined to approve additional Jeff Zeckel points to a retirement units. There was some discussion about housing in the downtown, but "downtown" appeared to mean different locations to

"I have people stop in my office quite often looking for downtown apartments. I do believe that there is a demand for apartments that residents could walk to the downtown amenities. That being said, I don't think we need a large complex that will overshadow our downtown area," Ayer

"I would need to see some specifics," Zeckel talked about downtown. "Are we going to tear down older homes to make room for an apartment complex? The west side of White River would have more potential than the east side for units similar to the ones in the downtown Carmel area, in my opinion."

"The west side of the river might be good for apartments," Taylor said." Maybe around the Kroger area.

"Something near the downtown, west of the river," suggests Wood. "I don't think we want condos in the greater downtown.'

Boice has a different view of 'downtown." He said, "We've been trying to develop South 8th Street; maybe a little more south would be a good spot for townhouses, condos and apartments."

eight months. After that, a cat is a senior, and then divided into either the longhair or the shorthair category.

Maris Bulger's cat Sammie is a longhair, but actually came to the fair with short hair. She had to deal with matted fur, so the Bulger family had to shave her. It didn't matter - Sammie won an honor ribbon and a blue ribbon.

"We liked the haircut because it doesn't really hurt her," said Bulger. The matted fur was uncomfortable for the cat, and Bulger said that Sammie is "a lot happier and nicer now" with her new haircut - even though Sammie wasn't feeling too sociable on Saturday.

"She's hiding in the corner right now," said Bulger, 9, who will be a fourth-grader at Our Lady of Grace in a few weeks.

In addition to the cat show itself, some of the 4-Hers enter the cage decorating contest, where they pick a theme for their cat's cage and decorate it accordingly. Also, anyone beyond their first year in the cat project must prepare an exhibit or poster. Morgan said it can be about any subject, as long as it's related to cats.

"They also have the opportunity to participate in what we call the cat knowledge portion," said Morgan. That involves a written test as well as an oral test.

Cats are popular with younger 4-Hers - in fact there was one first-year member who was showing an 18-year-old cat. Morgan said that she's noticed the average age of the cat are getting older as the years go by.

again until you can feel the Truth of that statement lifting something unnecessary from your shoulders.




