Interesting pairings in Carmel....

Power teams in top bracket

The powers are in the top bracket and the darkhorses in the bottom bracket. Should make for an interesting sectional and an interesting finish to the sectional.

But, Class 4A, Sectional 8 always is interesting.

This year's tourney at Carmel has powerhouses Fishers, North Central and Carmel in the top bracket. In the bottom bracket are Westfield, Hamilton Southeastern, Zionsville and Noblesville, a foursome certainly capable of pulling off an upset when the championship game is played.

All first round matches will be rematches of regular season contests. Eighteen games during the regular season have been played matching Sectional 8 teams.

Arguably the top two teams, Carmel and North Central could meet in the semifinal game in the top bracket. Carmel is 19-2 on the year and North Central currently has a 15-5 record. North Central, in a game played on the Panthers' home court, defeated Carmel, 66-59, back on Dec. 12.

But, before Carmel and North Central can stage a backyard rematch, NC will have to defeat a very good Fishers team. The Tigers this past weekend clinched the Hoosier Crossroads Conference championship with a 68-55 victory over Zionsville. Fishers has a 12-9 overall record.

Also this past weekend, Carmel clinched the MIC Conference crown when the Greyhounds defeated Warren Central and North Central was upset by Center Grove.

Carmel has beaten all of the sectional opponents, except for the loss to North Central. All of those wins were double digit victories. In the five Carmel victories against sectional opponents, Noblesville came the closest, losing 55-45.

Fishers is 4-2 against Sectional 8 teams. The Tigers have lost to Carmel 59-46 and Fishers has lost to opening game opponent North Central, 69-47 in a Dec. 29 holiday tourney game at North Central.

North Central has lost its last two games, the upset dished out by Center Grove and then a 38-34 loss to a very good Carroll team.

Carmel has won six in a row, dating back to a 36-33, Jan. 24 loss to Brownsburg. That was the tourney hosts' only defeat this season at the Eric Clark Activity Central, home of the sectional.

Fishers has won three of its last four games, falling only to a good Pendleton Heights quintet, 50-48.

In the bottom bracket of Sectional 8 will be rematches between Westfield and Hamilton Southeastern and Noblesville and Zionsville.

Southeastern, at home, beat Westfield 72-43 on Jan. 16. Noblesville, at home, lost to Zionsville 55-41 the same night, Jan. 16.

Hamilton Southeastern (7-15) and Westfield (4-17) will be the only teams in the seven team field with losing records. Noblesville is 12-10 and Zionsville is 17-6.

Eleven of Southeastern's 15 losses have been by 10 points or less; nine by six points or less.

Westfield played one of its best games of the season last weekend, beating New Castle 70-53.

Noblesville has lost four of its last six games. Two of those losses were in overtime to Mt. Vernon and Lawrence Central. Another loss was a two-pointer to Southeastern. Noblesville has posted impressive wins over Pike and Avon in the Millers' last three games.

Zionsville had won 10 straight before the big conference loss to Fishers last Friday. Then, on Saturday the Eagles lost by 10 to Tech.

Could go far in Class 3A

The great thing about the IHSAA’s Class 3A tourney this season for Hamilton County basketball fans is that two local team could go far.

First, of course, they have to win sectional championships.

Hamilton Heights will play in the sectional at Muncie Central. Guerin Catholic will play in the Indianapolis Marshall Sectional.

Heights’ Huskies have drawn a first round bye and will await the winner of a matchup between Muncie Central and Delta.

Guerin Catholic will start with a tourney-opening contest with Herron.

At Muncie Central, Yorktown (16-5) and Hamilton Heights (16-7) own the best records. They are the only teams at the Muncie Sectional with winning records.

But, in the second game of the season, Muncie Central defeated Yorktown 65-56.

Hamilton Heights hasn’t faced any team in the Muncie field.

The Huskies, likely, will get another shot at Muncie Central. The Bearcats (9-11) back on Dec. 20 defeated first-round foe Delta, 72-61. Delta is just 7-15 at this point in the season.

Hamilton Heights has clashed with Muncie Central all three years the Huskies have been assigned to the Muncie Central. The Bearcats romped in the first meeting three years ago, 69-35. Two years ago the Huskies beat Muncie Central 60-42 and won the sectional. Last year, Central edged the Huskies 53-47.

Muncie Central may not have a cakewalk against Delta. The Bearcats have lost four straight and five of six and this week will close the regular season playing a very good Frankton team at Frankton.

But, Delta hasn’t played well down the stretch. The Eagles have lost three straight and five of six. This week Delta will end its regular season taking on another Muncie Central Sectional foe, a 0-22 Blackford team.

In the other bracket of this sectional, Yorktown will face Blackford. On Jan. 10, Yorktown defeated Blackford, 50-26. Yorktown has beaten Delta twice, 51-40 and 58-55.

Yorktown is on a hot streak, having won four straight and 12 of 13. This week, Yorktown will host Richmond and play at Mt. Vernon.

Hamilton Heights has won its last seven games and this Friday will be going for a full share of the Mid-Indiana Conference in a game at Peru.

At the Marshall Sectional, Guerin Catholic’s 14-8 record is the best among the five-team field. Also with winning records are Brebeuf at 12-9 and Guerin’s first foe, Herron, at 12-7.

Guerin Catholic is 3-0 against Marshall Sectional teams with wins over Herron 70-44, Chatard 73-50 and Brebeuf 65-48.

All of which makes Guerin Catholic a heavy favorite to win the sectional.

Chatard is just 8-14. Marshall, the host, is only 6-14.

Guerin Catholic, which by far plays the toughest sectional in the Marshall Sectional field, had a two-game win string snapped last weekend in an overtime loss at Pendleton Heights. The Golden Eagles have won four of their last six games.

Herron, Guerin’s opening game foe, is 1-3 against Marshall Sectional teams. Along with the loss to Guerin, the Achaeans also have lost to Brebeuf 86-54 and Marshall 71-63 and have defeated Marshall, 67-66, in another game between the two teams.

University headed for showdown with Tindley???

Sheridan opens with Elwood

Arguably, the best two teams in the Class 1A Sectional at Bethesda Christian, University and Tindley, have drawn into different brackets and can't meet until the championship game.

Hamilton County's other small school, Class 2A Sheridan, has drawn the team with the worst record, Elwood, in the Tipton Sectional.

Sheridan is 5-15 overall and 1-2 against Tipton Sectional teams. That one win was a Jan. 17 65-62 decision over Elwood, at Sheridan.

Elwood is 3-17 overall and 0-7 against the sectional field.

Sheridan's two losses against possible sectional foes were a 42-39 setback at Taylor on Dec. 20 and an 85-41 kicking at Tipton on Jan. 16.

If Sheridan wins its first round matchup against Elwood, the Blackhawks will meet the winner of the Taylor-Tipton game.

Four of the seven teams playing in this sectional have winning records. Tipton is 14-4 overall and the Blue Devils are 4-0 against sectional teams, including an early-February 49-35 win over Taylor.

Madison-Grant is 11-9; Alexandria 11-10 and Eastern 11-11.

Tindley (12-10) and University (14-9) have the best records in the Bethesda Christian Sectional. Indiana Deaf is 15-6 and International is 10-12.

University has defeated International 71-53 and Indiana Deaf 64-54 the last three weeks. However, University lost to Tindley, 68-59, back on Jan. 9 at Tindley.

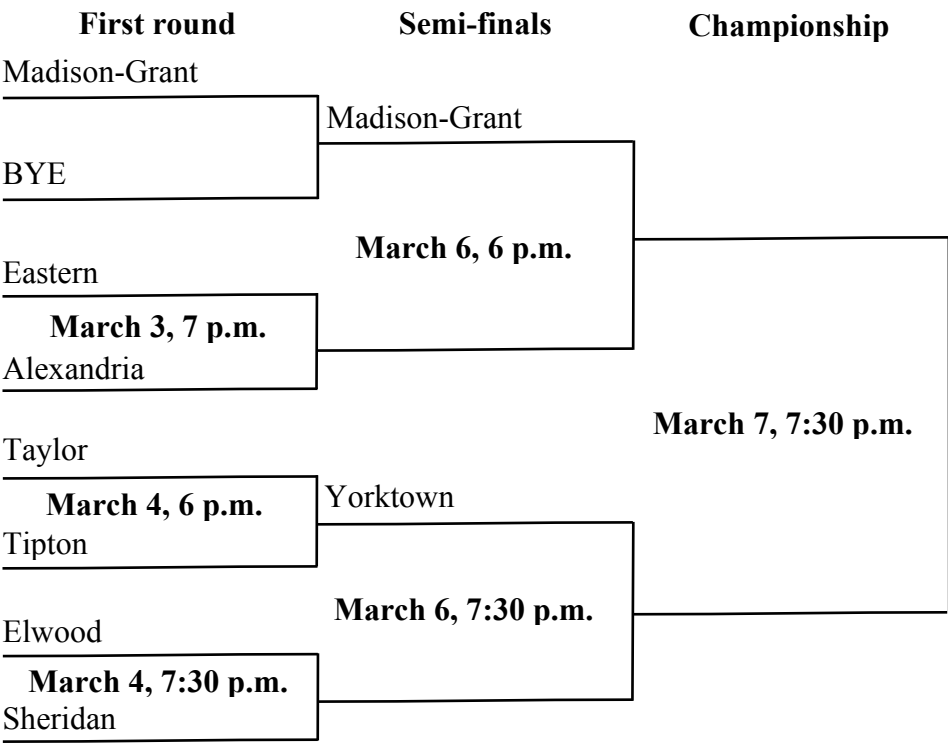
University will open the sectional in a game against Indiana Math & Science, which is just 4-18. The two teams did not meet during the regular season.



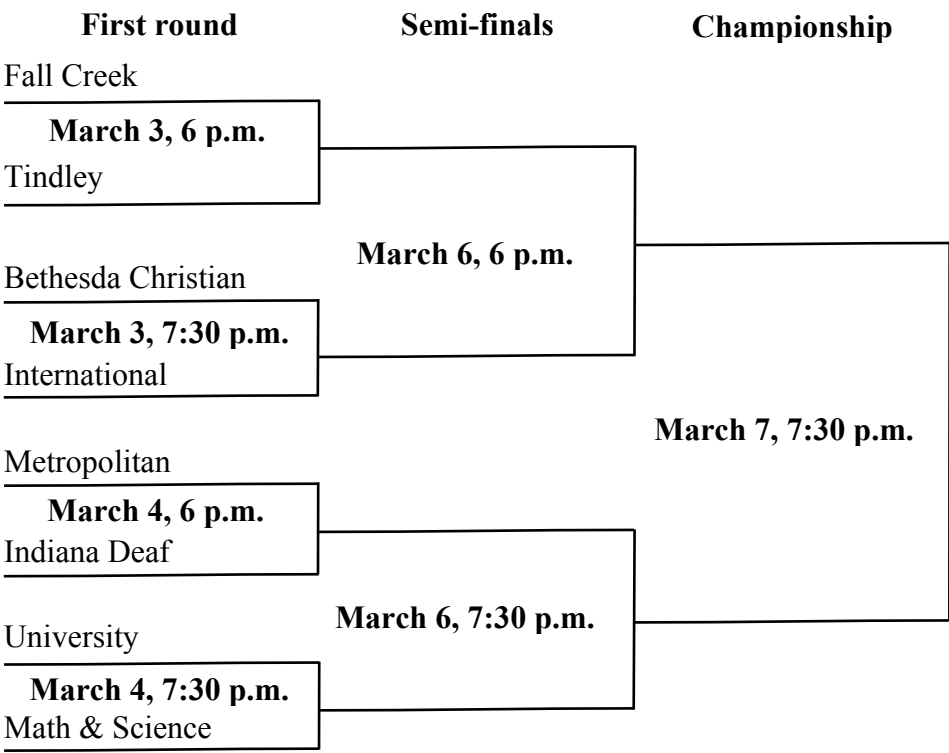

The 105th annual boys basketball tournament: Facts and numbers

Three hundred ninety-seven (397) teams were drawn today and placed into brackets for the 105th Annual IHSAA Boys Basketball State Tournament *presented by the Indiana Pacers and Indiana Fever*.

This is the second year that both of the state's professional basketball franchises have been presenting sponsors of the boys and girls high school state tournaments.

Sectional games are scheduled to begin Tuesday, March 3, and run through Saturday, March 7, with the regional round slated for March 14 and semistates on March 21. The four state championship games that make up the state finals will be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis on Saturday, March 28.

Evansville Reitz is the top-ranked team in both the Associated Press Class 4A poll and the single class poll from the Indiana Basketball Coaches Association. The Panthers will begin their quest for their first sectional championship since 2008 against host Evansville North in the Sectional 16 opener.

Class 3A's No. 1 team Mishawaka Marian drew a bye into the semifinals and will face the Glenn-Rochester winner in Sectional 19 at South Bend St. Joseph.

Covington, the top-ranked Class A squad, drew Lafayette Central Catholic in the opening game of Sectional 53 at North Vermillion.

In Class 2A, defending state champion and No. 1 Park Tudor will meet Indianapolis Shortridge, the host of Sectional 42.

Among the other defending state champions, two-time defending Class 3A winner Greensburg will host Lawrenceburg in Sectional 29.

Marquette Catholic, the defending state champion in Class A, drew Westville in Sectional 49 at Kouts.

Indianapolis Arsenal Technical, which won its first state basketball championship last year in Class 4A, drew a bye into the semifinals and will take on the Indianapolis

Cathedral-Warren Central winner in Sectional 10 at Lawrence Central.

Lafayette Central Catholic (Class A) leads the state with 13 consecutive sectional championships. Andrean (Class 3A) and Pioneer (Class A) are next having won five in a row.

About the Draw

To conduct the random drawing for the boys basketball state tournament, the IHSAA places ping-pong balls representing each school in a given sectional into a lottery-style air mix machine. A motorized fan in the bottom of the machine blows the balls around the inside of the transparent container and air then forces each ball up through a tube in random order. For example, the first ball retrieved from the machine will be the visiting team in game one with the second ball representing the home team in game one. The third ball to come out is the visitor in game two and the fourth ball the home team in game two. That same method is followed through all 64 sectionals and 16 regionals.
