Individuals and youth from churches around the country will spend one week in Hamilton County performing hands-on home repair projects for elderly, low-income, and veteran residents and families struggling with home repair needs. The work at each home will be done by five young people and at least one adult leader representing many Christian denominations. Home repair projects will be completed between June 16 and 20, 2025.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who is doing the repairs? CrossRoads Church at Westfield is partnering with Group Mission Trips, a non-profit youth mission organization. Group Mission Trips will provide youth and adults to perform the repairs. Adults with related experience will oversee all projects as well.

When are the repairs being done? Repairs will be done June 16-20, 2025.

How will the repairs be done? 200-300 high school students and their youth leaders will travel from various states and stay in Westfield for one week. Each day, Monday through Friday, work crews made up of 5-7 youth and adults will be sent to homes chosen to receive repairs. Each work crew will perform repairs on the same home for the entire week.

Since 1990, Group Mission Trips has connected over 500,000 youth and their youth leaders with local communities to provide over 14 million hours of service through the completion of free home repairs. To learn more about Group Mission Trips, visit their website at groupmissiontrips.com

What repairs will be done? Work crews are prepared to complete the repairs listed on the application's front. Other minor repairs may be completed, depending on the difficulty of the projects and the skills of the youth and adults performing the repairs. Projects that cannot be completed and will not be considered for repairs include plumbing and electrical work.

What will the repairs cost me? If your home is selected, the repairs are free.

How can I be assured the repairs will be done well? Youth and adults are evaluated based on their skills, and they are matched to homes where they can perform the needed repairs. Trained construction coaches will oversee the repairs and guide the participants in their work throughout the week.

How will I know I am chosen for the repairs? After you submit your application, our local organizer will call you to schedule a visit to your home. Two local representatives from CrossRoads will visit your home to meet you and discuss and take pictures of your requested repairs. In late Spring, our team will review all submitted applications. Letters will be mailed that will notify you whether or not your home has been selected. Please note that through this process, we cannot guarantee that your home will be chosen to receive repairs.
